OVERVIEW

The meeting of the RFI Selection Committee, will be held on 24 Jun 2018 at the ARN Pune at 1100 O'clock.

The meeting will follow the criteria for selection, as uploaded on the web-site of the Federation.

The meeting will analyse the data of the coaching camp of the performance of individual rowers and the boat combinations, which have shown consistent progress on the 2000 M testing carried out by Mr Nicolae Gioga, the Foreign expert and High-Performance Director in charge of the training.

The Committee will decide on the crew in various boats, which are the fastest and have a fair chance of winning medals at the Games.

Adequate reserves will be identified, as per the guidelines issued by the Asian Games Organising Committee.

To consider and finalise the entries to represent India at the 2018 Asian Games, Palembang, Indonesia, to be held from 19 – 25 August 2018.
