## Dear Friends,

We have had some complaints / issues regarding <u>selection of some of your teams'</u> and their entry in the "National Rowing Championships" from various quarters, for some time now.

Please follow these simple and important steps when you select your state / association team for the National Games / National Rowing Championships in <u>future</u>, <u>as a normal procedure</u>.

This is part of RFI's drive for inculcating principles of "Good Governance amongst Affiliate Members" and "Transparency" in their Workings, as insisted upon by the <u>Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India</u>

#### Step 1

- 1. Clearly announce the Regatta Name and Details of the Races which is coming up well in advance, in writing.
- 2. Follow RFI Rules of Racing in all respects, without deviation
- 3. Place the <u>NOTICE</u> in a prominent place where all your Rowers / Coaches will be normally present and will look for such Notices.
- 4. This Notice can be put up in the local language which your Rowers and Coaches normally speak / understand.

#### Step 2

- Announce a <u>Selection Date</u>, well in advance, prominently through a Notice, in a language that all the Rowers / Coaches in your association understand.
- 2. The selection notice should invariably contain, among other things, the following important information:
  - a. Date and Time of Selection
  - Events for which Selection's will take place & whether doubling between sculls and sweeps is allowed or not
  - Distance of the Race & Mode of Selection [like say best of 3 or best of 5 races & race distance for selection etc]
  - d. The Boats to be used for Selections to be disclosed
  - e. The Selection Committee to be named, well in Advance. Avoid Persons with "conflict of Interest" in the Selection Committee.

#### Step 3

- 1. Have a Fair Selection for the Races Announced.
- 2. Issue Matched Boats of same make and weight to all contestants in a particular race.
- 3. If the Conditions are BAD on the Selection Date, explore possibility of postponing selections to a <u>Later Time or Date</u>, time permitting.

# Step 4

- After the Selections are over the Selectors must write out a Simple <u>Selection Minutes</u> containing a List of the Rowers finally selected from your State / Association.
- 2. A Model Minutes is attached for your Guidance. You can modify the same to suit your needs
- 3. Signed Minutes must be filed at your end for record. In case, there are Disputes these can be relied on.

### Step 5

- 1. If there are any objections / disputes please have a System / Committee to solve the same immediately.
- 2. Do not let the problem grow and multiply and let bad feeling carry on to the Championships.
- 3. Give a patient hearing to the Rowers and take a Correct / Fair Decision with "Compassion and Firmness".
- 4. Do not be rash and autocratic in your Interaction with the Rowers or their Coaches.
- 5. Have a hand held Digital Camera / Handy Cam at the finish line for all Selection Races.
