## Competition Information:

### 1. Date and Place:

The competition will be held on the Hussain Sagar Lake, Hyderabad, Telangana from the 27<sup>th</sup> May to 01 Jun 2025.

### 2. Events:

- 2.1 The competition course will be on 4 lanes with fixed start platforms over a distance of 500 meters.
- 2.2 DOUBLING: Doubling allowed only in Quadruple Scull event. Only U15 Single Sculls & U15 Double Sculls can double in Quadruple Scull.
- 2.3 No doubling in Events between Under 13 Years & 15 Years.
- 2.4 If there are less than 5 (Five) entries in any event, then the event may be scrapped.

### **3. Eligibility:**

National Rowing Championships are open to the following:

- 3.1 All Affiliates of RFI
- 3.2 Any Organization or Institution to which the Federation has granted affiliation, as an Associate Member.
- 3.3 Association, Organization or Institution registered in India as invitees of Rowing Federation of India.
- 3.4 Only 'Nationals of India' - i.e. 'Citizens of India' will be eligible to participate in these Championships. 'National of India' shall mean and include a person as defined in Chapter II of the Constitution of India, who is a full-fledged Citizen of India, holding an Indian Passport.
- 3.5 Explanation of "National of India": Holder of a Foreign Passport, Dual Citizenship will not be considered as a 'National of India'. A 'Person of India Origin' [PIO] or 'Overseas Citizen of India' [OCI] not eligible to participate in Races conducted by / under the aegis of the RFI

### **4. The eligibility criteria for Sub-Juniors are:**

- 4.1 For the under 15 years Events - A Rower (Boy or Girl) is considered to be as Sub Junior till 31st December in the year in which he/she reaches the age of 15 years.  
(Born on or after 01 Jan 2010)
- 4.2 For the under 13 years Events - A Rower (Boy or Girl) is considered to be a Sub Junior till 31st December in the year in which he/she reaches the age of 13 years.  
(Born on or after 01 Jan 2012)

### **5. Entries:**

- 5.1 **Preliminary Entry (Entry by boat)** should be received by the Organizing Committee and the RFI Secretariat on or before the **25th of April 2025**.
- 5.2 **Final Entry (Entry by name)** must be received by the Organizing Committee and the RFI Secretariat on or before **12th May 2025**.

- 5.3 The Final Entry must include the name and date of birth of each rower including substitutes (**not more than three - one in scull and two in sweep-one bow side and one stroke side, as reserves**) and the names of team officials (**not more than two-one coach and one manager-for full team**). Entries must be in the format provided only.
- 5.4 All entries must be submitted in the official forms attached herewith only with RFI Recognized State Secretaries' signature & stamp. If there are corrections and overwriting, the same must be attested with signature & stamp of the rfi recognized state secretary concerned.

**6. Detailed Procedure for Entry Submission:**

- 6.1 Enter all details and names in **CAPITAL LETTERS (Only)**
- 6.2 Attach entry form to email and send it to '**Organizing Secretaries**' email id and mark a copy to RFI Secretariat's email id.
- 6.3 The form to be duly signed by the rfi recognized state Secretary of the association and stamped.
- 6.4 Take a printout and bring this original Entry Form to Championship venue and hand it over personally to Organizing Secretary / President of Jury.
- 6.5 **All new rowers must be registered before sending final entry form. Without RFI ID number entry form will not be accepted.**

**Note:**

- a) Change of names of rowers will be accepted till 28th May 2025 or before the draws are made by the Jury.
- b) Entries received after the closure date or before the draws, will not be accepted and the concerned crew will not be allowed to participate.

**7. Schedule:**

Friday 30th May 2025	Repechage- 500m

Sunday 01st Jun 2025	Finals (& late evening Departures)
Monday 02 <sup>nd</sup> Jun 2025	Departure

**Note:**

- a) The schedule is subject to change. Changes will be notified to all Associations by new version of the bulletin.
- b) official Accommodation will be available only between 10:00 hrs on 27th May 2025 and upto 1200 hrs on 02 Jun 2025, Teams arriving early or leaving late have to make their own arrangements for accommodation for early arrival and late departures.

**8. Association Flag:**

The teams are requested to bring the Flags of their respective State Associations.

**9. Rules and Regulations:**

- 9.1 The competition will be conducted in accordance with the RFI Rules of Racing.
- 9.2 All teams must wear their racing uniforms as per the officially approved colors. Teams violating this rule will not be permitted to participate in the races.

## **10. Boats and Equipment**

- 10.1 Boats will be fixed to the Lane.
- 10.2 All oars and sculls must be painted on both sides in the colors of their respective State Association.
- 10.3 Teams will be responsible for the breakages And damages to the boats and equipment's provided by the organizers. The decision of the Jury will be final in determining The extent of damage and cost to be paid.
- 10.4 No coxless boat will be allowed to start without a rudder. Use of rudder in Fours and Pairs is mandatory as per RFI Rules.

## **11. Transportation**

- 11.1 For attention of all Participants, Officials, Coaches and Managers who are travelling by air. Have to reach venue with your own arrangements.
- 11.2 Pickup from railway station to hotel and drop at venue and back will be provided by Organization.
- 11.7 Daily pick up and drop from place of stay to the venue of the competition and back will be provided by the organizers.

## **12. Entry Fee, Participation Fee, Boarding and Lodging**

- 12.1 Entry fee of Rs. 1000.00 per participant to be paid to RFI, and those who are doubling in quadruple scull have to pay Rs 500/- extra along with entry form.
- 12.2 Boarding and Lodging charges of Rs. 800/- per person / per day will be collected from all sub junior participant, and max four officials whose name is mentioned in the entry form.
- 12.3 Extra Officials / Players / Support Staff / Parents and guardians who accompany the team, have to find your own accommodation in

Hyderabad or paid as per organization guidelines and should be inform in advance.

**13. Appeals**

All appeals shall be dealt with in accordance with RFI Rules of Racing.

**14. Medals and Certificates**

Medals and Certificates will be presented to first three winners in each event and Participation Certificates will be issued, as per the qualifying provisions, laid down by the RFI.
