

(10) Affiliation Criteria of State / UT Along with Details of Voting Rights of Each Unit

ARTICLE – 6 (AFFILIATION)

- 6.1
The Organisations wishing to become a member of the Rowing Federation of India shall make a formal application to Secretary General of Rowing Federation of India.
- 6.2
Submit with its application a copy of its statutes and a detailed report on activities of clubs which it represents.
- 6.3
Provide details of the membership of its committee and the design and colors of its racing uniform and its blades.
- 6.4
Give a formal undertaking to observe the Statutes and Rules of Racing, Bye-Laws and Regulations of RFI.
- 6.5
Undertake to accept as binding and final, the decisions of the competent authorities within RFI and in this regard, to recognize the Arbitration clause of RFI, IOA and ICAS as the only possible external judicial authority, for adjudication of disputes.
- 6.6
Undertake to impose its obligation in 6.4 & 6.5 above upon its Members and its Affiliated Clubs and their Members in all those areas where RFI has authority.
- 6.7
Pay an entrance fee the amount of which shall be fixed from time to time
- 6.8
Be accepted by a majority of two thirds of persons present and voting at meeting of the Council or General Body
- 6.9
Each organization, on being affiliated to the RFI, shall send to the Secretary General the proper mailing addresses, telephone nos, official email id and fax details. All notices sent by the Secretary General to the name, address, official email id given shall be deemed to have been properly sent to the affiliated organization whether received or not.
- 6.10
Every affiliated organisation shall submit a report of its Annual activities from 1 st April to 31 st March of previous year by 30th June and when required a list of its members and a copy of the last balance sheet.

ARTICLE – 19 (VOTING)

- 19.1
Each affiliated organization/body, except Associate Members, shall have 3 (three) votes in the Annual General Meeting and Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting. The chair of such meetings shall have a casting vote.
- 19.2
Each affiliated organization / body shall have the right to have maximum of 3 (three) delegates including Councilors, if any, accredited to represent them, but the number of delegates shall not alter the voting strength of 3 (three) for each affiliated Organisation / Body.
- 19.3
Councilors shall take precedence over other delegates in arriving at the voting strength of 3 from each affiliate.
- 19.4
Every office bearer shall be entitled to one vote.
