Sir,

Further to Administrative Approval issued from file of even number dated 19.07.2019 on the above subject. I am directed to convey the Financial Sanction of Competent Authority, in principle, for the subject International Exposure, as per following break-up of financial assistance and Terms and Conditions:-

- 2. I am also directed to convey the sanction of Competent Authority for release of Rs.7,50,150/- (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand One hundred Fifty Only) to Rowing Federation of India for making arrangements for Boarding & Lodging, Boat hire-single skull, mixed coxed, bike hire, adaptive oars etc. Approved is also conveyed for release of Rs. 1,44,000/- on account of payment of OPA to 08 members @ Rs. 18,000/ per head. The full and final payment will be made on receipt of original bill & vouchers.
- **3.** The amount sanctioned herein will be drawn by the Drawing & Disbursing Officer, Sports Authority of India on the prescribed bill immediately for disbursing the same to grantee through Electronic Clearing System. This grant is of non-recurring nature.
- 4. The grant is subject to the conditions mentioned below:-
- (i) That the grantee shall execute a bond for the full amount of grant in the prescribed proforma on a non-judicial stamp paper in acceptance of the terms and conditions of the grant duly executed by the authorized signatory of the grantee and two sureties and witnesses with complete permanent addresses.
- (ii) The grantee shall maintain subsidiary accounts of the grant received from the Sports Authority of India.
- (iii) The grantee shall maintain the register of assets in the prescribed form GFR-19. The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the grant except those declared as obsolete and unserviceable or condemned as per the procedure laid down in the General Financial Rules shall not be disposed off without the prior approval of the Sports Authority of India.
- (iv) The grantee shall not divert the grants and entrust execution of the scheme or work concerned to another Institution or Organizations and shall abide by the terms & conditions of the grant. If the grantee fails to utilize the grant, for the purpose for which the same has been sanctioned, the grantee will required to refund the entire amount of the grant with interest thereon @ 10% per annum.
- (v) The Utilization Certificate in the prescribed form GFR 19 A disclosing whether the specified, quantified and qualitative targets that should have been reached against the amount utilized, were in fact reached and if not the reasons therefore should be submitted within six months of the completion of the programme along with the audited statement of accounts. The UC should be checked and signed by the Chartered Accountant with reference to the initial and subsidiary accounts of the grant to be maintained by the grantee as per GFRs.
- (vi) The performance-cum-achievement report in respect of the above event for which the grant has been sanctioned should be forwarded to the TEAMS DIVISION, Sports Authority of India with a copy to Government Observer within one week of the completion of event.

- (vii) That some photographs of the events, i.e. events, medal winners etc. with sample invitation cards for opening and closing ceremony and copies of newspaper clippings related to the event preferably in National and Regional dailies be sent to this office along with performance-cum-achievement report.
- (viii) That the amount in INR will be subject to the actual rate of Foreign Exchange on the date of payment by the Federation. The difference, if any, in INR will be adjusted.
- (ix) There is no reason to believe that the grantee is involved in corrupt practice.
- (x) That no advertisement of Tobacco and Liquor will be displayed during the event, the breach of which entails the cancellation of grant.
- (xi) Amount of grant should be utilized only for the purpose for which it is sanctioned and unspent balance of grant shall be refunded by the grantee institution immediately after conclusion of the event.
- (xii) The grantee should maintain separate accounts for the grants released by the Sports Authority of India. The accounts of the amount so paid to the grantee shall be open to check by an officer deputed by Sports Authority of India or the Government in addition to other statutory authorities to ensure proper utilization of the funds and that no profits are earned out this.
- (xiii) The grantee shall also submit consolidated accounts of the grants received from other Ministries/Departments/State Governments for detailed checking by the Sports Authority of India, in addition to the separate annual accounts on the activities implemented with the grants released by the Sports Authority of India.
- (xiv) The grant is further subject to the conditions laid down in General Financial Rules as amended from time to time.
- (xv) The fact the programme is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports/ Sports Authority of India should be prominently highlighted and displayed while inviting people and holding functions/programmes/events etc.
- (xvi) When the Sports Authority of India/Government of India/State Government has reasons to believe that the sanctioned money is not being utilized for the approved purposes, the payment of the grant will be stopped. If the reply to the show cause notice is not satisfactory, the earlier grant will be recovered with interest as mentioned in Clause IV above.
- (xvii) The grantee institution or organization should exercise reasonable economy in the working of the approved projects.
- (xviii)As per GFR-212(1), the accounts of grantee institution or organization shall be opened to inspection by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports/Sports Authority of India and audit, both by the Comptroller and Auditor General of India under the provision of CAG (DPC) Act, 1971 and Internal Audit of Sports Authority of India, New Delhi, whenever the grantee is called upon to do so.

- 5. The above sanction has been issued under the powers delegated to the Director General/Secretary/Executive Director of Sports Authority of India. It is certified that the grant being released is in conformity with the rules and regulations of the scheme as approved by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports.
- 6. The amount of **Rs 7,50,150/-** (Rupees Seven Lakh Fifty Thousand One hundred Fifty Only) shall be drawn and transferred to the Rowing Federation Of India as advance and also release of **Rs. 1,44,000/-** @ **Rs. 18,000/-** per person on account of payment of out of Pocket Allowance directly in bank account of 08 Members.
- 7. The amount of grant will be debitable to the Major Head 49.0500 (Assistance to National Sports Federations) for the Financial Year 2019-2020.

- 3. Section 9 of FC (R) Act, 1976, provides inter-alia that no member of a legislature, Office bearer of a political party judge, Government servant or employee of any Corporation shall accept any foreign hospitality without the prior permission of the Central Government. In case, any team member is covered under the above act, he/she obtain the prior permission from Ministry of Home Affairs before their departure to above competition.
- 4. As per item 9 of Schedule II of the foreign Exchange management (current Account transactions) Rules 2000, International /National/State level, sports Bodies are not required to take permission of the Ministry or Reserve Bank of India for remittance of prize money/ sponsorship of sports activity.
- 5. Such of the team-member who might be Central Government servants are to be treated as on duty (which includes deputation aboard) in respect of this participation by the Department/Office in which they are employed in terms of Department Personnel & Training O M. No. 6. /2185-Estt. (Pay-I) dated 30-1-1989. The Federation should inform their employing Department/Office accordingly.
- 6. In view of the disappearance of some officials /sportspersons in the European countries, in the recent past, the federation would be responsible for return of contingent of one player of squash mentioned above in India and therefore background /antecedents of the team members may be checked properly by the concerned Federation.
- 7. It is requested that the concerned Indian High commission/Embassy of the visiting country and the organizers of the event may please be informed of the travel plans and itinerary of the delegation for participation in the above event. The team members may be advised to call on the Mission for exchange of views.
- 8. Before departure of the team report of Dope Test of the members of team may be ascertained from National Anti Doping Agency, New Delhi.
- 9. Detailed report on the visit of the team along-with its performance /achievements and action photographs in the above event is required to be sent to Sports Authority of India within 7 days of the return of the team to India along with some action photographs.
