## ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION NO: 39

I am directed to convey the approval of the Competent Authority to conduct the National Coaching Camp for Senior Para (M&W) Rowers for 8 Campers (4 Men + 3 Women + 1 Coach) at Army Rowing Node (ARN), Pune from 13th May, 2019 to 16th June, 2019 (35 days).

## The Terms & Conditions for the Camp will be as under-

- Camp duration 13th May, 2019 to 16th June, 2019 (35 days).
- 2. Boarding Charges @ Rs.690/head/day for 7 Rowers for 35 days.
- 3. Lodging Charges for 1 Man & 3 Women @ Rs. 1000/- per head /day for 35 days.
- **4.** Transportation from Hotel to Camp & Back @ Rs. 1000/- per day (Disabled Rowers) for 6 trips (Training Days only) for 30 days.
- 5. Nutritional Supplements for 7 Rowers @ Rs.430/- per head/day for 35 days.
- **6.** Sports Kits @ Rs. 10,000/- per head for 7 Rowers & 1 Coach.
- 7. Travelling Charge as per MYAS letter No.12-5/2013-SP-III.dated 4/11/2015.
- 8. Boat maintenance & OBM Servicing As per actual billing
- Medical as per norms.
- 10. List of Players, Coaches & Supporting Staff enclosed.
- 11. Any inclusion/ deletion of National Campers should not be entertained without prior approval of the TEAMS Division.
- 12. On conclusion of the National Coaching Camp, National Coach/Coach Incharge shall submit a report on Coaching Camp through the Director of the concerned Regional Centre within 10 days to the RD (TEAMS). The Director I/C concerned shall also submit the expenditure statement for the camp within a month to the ED (F) with a copy to the TEAMS Division.
- 13. The expenditure will be debited under the Head "General Assistance for Holding Coaching Camp
- 14. All bills pertaining to the Camp shall be submitted within 21 days of completion of the camp.
- **15.** All the equipments (consumables and non-consumables) issued for the camp has to be entered in the stock and issue register and shall be returned to the camp Incharge on completion of the camp.
- 16. Attendance of all the campers is to be maintained and monitored on daily basis.
